## Clark County School District ECSE/PRE-K Immunization Requirements 2020/2021 School Year

Below are the immunizations, per Nevada Revised Statute 392.435, that are required before entering an ECSE/Pre-K Program. Once enrolled, a child who turns 4 years of age has 30 days to complete the required immunizations pursuant to NRS 392.435 and 394.192.

## 4 DTP or DTaP

(minimum age: 6 weeks)

## 2 HEP A

(minimum age: 12 months)

#### 3 HEP B

(minimum age: Birth)

## 1 MMR

(minimum age: 12 months)

## 3 Polio

(minimum age: 6 weeks)

## 1 Varicella

(minimum age: 12 months)

# AGE 4

#### 5 DTP or DTaP

 5<sup>th</sup> dose not needed if 4<sup>th</sup> dose given on/or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose.

## 2 HEP A

 2<sup>nd</sup> dose must be given at least 6 months after the 1<sup>st</sup> dose

## 3 HEP B

- 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose must be separated by 4 weeks.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> dose must be separated by at least 8 weeks.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> dose at least 16 weeks after the 1<sup>st</sup> dose (Minimum age for final dose- 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> dose is 24 weeks)

## 2 MMR

Compliant if 2 doses at least 4 weeks apart

## 3-4 Polio

- 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose and 2nd and 3rd dose must be at least 4 weeks apart
- Final dose (3rd or 4th dose) at least 6 months after previous dose and on or after 4th birthday
- 4th dose not needed if 3rd dose given on or after 4th birthday.

<u>2 Varicella</u> 1șt and 2nd dose should be separated by 3 months
