2025-2026 School Budget

- No budget update.

- Ms. Richards is exploring grants and other possible sources of funding.

School Performance Plan review:

Goal 1:

Increase the percentage of students achieving at or above the 61st percentile from 46% to 51% on the ELA MAP assessments, spring 2024-spring 2025.

In fall 2024-2025 the percentage of students, grades K-5 scoring above the 61st percentile was 41. In winter, student achievement grew to 55 percent of students scoring above the 61st percentile.

Goal 2:

Increase the percentage of teachers who will seek feedback from instructional leaders and use a variety of data to self-reflect on his/her practice from 90% in 2024 to 100% in 2025.

Teachers are using dedicated PLC times to collaborate on data-analysis, lesson planning and instruction. Growth in student achievement can be attributed to effective PLCs.

Goal 3:

Decrease the percentage of students who are chronically absent from 8.6% at the end of 2023-2024 to 7.6% at the end of 2024-2025 as measured by the Quarterly Progress Monitoring Report in FocusED.

In fall 2024-2025 6.8 percent of students, grades K-5, were considered chronically absent. In winter, 4.7 percent of students are considered chronically absent.
